THE Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) today raided the residences of more than 58 senior Maharashtra Telephone Nigam Limited (MTNL) officials, including seven deputy general managers, in connection with the more than Rs 60 crore 'reinstatement' (RI) racket relating to 'ghost trenches' that came to light in 1998.

The raids that began at around 6 pm in the morning, continued till 11 pm in the evening and officials re-

covered cash and investment valued around Rs 1 crore. The raids were effected after a chargesheet was filed in a special court on Friday. More than 20 divisional engineers, 38 sub-divisional engineers and nine contractors have been named as accused in the First Information Report.

Some of the contractors have been identified as Singal and Brothers, Sundeep Constructions, Ram Builders, Dolchand Kallaji Engineers and Contractors, Phone Time System Communication Ltd, Tele Services, H M Enterprises and Abhinav Constructions.

A MTNL vigilance team under General Manager Sanjay Kumar and Deputy S R Singh began investigating into the RI scam after a newspaper report in *The Indian Express* in 1998. In fact, the contractors even offered Singh Rs 50 lakh and a flat to mislead investigations.

Website offers money to those who prove he sang above 4,965 songs

Chance for Rafi fans to make money

THIS one is for KBC enthusiasts. How many songs did the evergreen Mohamad Rafi sing? 5,000? 10,000 or more?

If you go by the numerous websites on the golden-voiced singer, you would put your finger on the more than 10,000 bracket. Documented material, however, indicates a scaled-down yet impressive total of roughly 4,965 songs against his name.

If you think you could bring to light any song by Rafi which was hitherto unknown, here is your chance to earn a bit of money.

A group of music enthusiasts who have set up an unmoderated music forum —

rec.music.indian.misc (RMIM) — devoted to Hindi film music, have thrown open a challenge to anyone who claims that Rafi has sung 10,000 songs. For bringing to light any new undocumented song by him, along with proof that he had lent his voice to it, collect US\$1 for every 10 new songs. The money grows exponentially for every song thereafter.

The forum has about 50 to 100 regular members, RMIMers as they call themselves, who are from all parts of the world. Most of them are from the US, as well as few from India, Pakistan as well as UK, Caribbean and Germany.

Surjit Singh, a former TIFR physicist who is currently employed with HNC Software at San Diego, and a self-professed Hindi music fan (atic), is one of the main persons behind the effort. "We got three responses so far," says Singh, "a guy from Mumbai claimed to have

12,000 songs by Rafi. When we told him about all the books on the singer, he withdrew his claim. Someone else sent me seven songs, but they were listed in the two books on the singer. Another guy from India has staked his claim, but he is in the process of cataloguing", talking to this newspaper through an e-mail interview.

"Intellectuals in India tend to be snobbish and dismiss Hindi movies as low art," says the former professor. "They are wrong. I was brought up in a small village in India and know how important Hindi movies are in Indian culture". For the 54-year-old physicist who calls himself a "a diehard movie fan (atic)", digging up hitherto unknown songs is "important as it adds to the raw data for the history of Hindi cinema".

There is another reason. As fellow music lover and RMIMer, Dhananjay Naniwadekar,

Chance for Rafi fans to make money

also based in the US puts it, "For years now people have been claiming that singers like Lata Mangeshkar, Mohammad Rafi have sung more than 20,000 songs. Well, now is the time for them to them to prove their claim and earn money or they should stop spreading this misinformation".

Documenting songs of Hindi films, has been a fairly recent exercise. Har Mandir Singh alias Hamraaz, did a yeoman service to film music fans by collecting data on songs and publishing four volumes of *Geet Kosh* (1931-1970) by 1988. The book, which is a sort of bible for music enthusiasts like Singh and Naniwadekar, contains indices of all films during the era, followed by the songs credited to their singers, actors, producers, directors, music directors and lyricists.

This, aided by two books specifically on Rafi — one by Ajit Pradhan and Preetam Meghani and the other by Iqbal Ganam and Asif Bakshi — puts the Hindi film songs sung by one of the lead singers of Hindi filmdom, at 4,525. Add to this some 440 documented non-film, non-Hindi songs and the grand total comes to 4,965.

And if one were to enter the numbers game, here's the score: Vishwas Nerurkar's definitive

books on Hindi film songs have serialised and listed songs sung by Lata Mangeshkar at 5,080. Add to this her non-film and non-Hindi songs and the total could come to around 6,000 to 6,500, say experts. Only in Asha Bhonsle's case, it is estimated that the singer has sung 8,000 Hindi film songs. She breasts the 10,000 mark since her other songs are expected to be in the range of 2,000 to 2,200.

Says Naniwadekar, "Hamraz's Geet Kosh has uncovered all the songs from old films. It is extremely unlikely that he has missed even a single song. But, it is possible that some of those songs may have been sung by Rafi, but are untraceable. The number of such songs is likely to be between five and 50 and would be from the 1940s." In fact, Naniwadekar was told that seven songs from the films, *Arab Ka Sitara*, *Banoo* and *Hawai Khatola* had not been attributed to Rafi by Hamraaz's Geet Kosh: "However, all these songs have been listed by the compilations on Rafi," he adds.

To Singh, though, the offer is a culmination of his life long obsession. He recounts that he could not sleep for three days once he laid his hands on the Geet Kosh Vol III in 1988. "The wealth of authentic information that he had collected left me amazed," he says. It is the same excitement with which he looks forward to uncover more songs of one of his favourite singers; though anyone with a claim would do well to check it out

बक्शी की है। इन पुस्तकों के अनुसार रफी ने हिन्दी फिल्मों के अलावा गैर हिन्दी फिल्मों में भी करीब चार सौ गीत गाए। इन्हें मिलाकर मोहम्मद रफी द्वारा गाए गए कुल गीतों की संख्या चार हजार 965 बैठती है। मोहम्मद रफी ने 1944 में गलबलोच में श्यामसुंदर के संगीत निर्देशन में पार्श्वगायन के क्षेत्र में कदम रखा और 31 जुलाई 1980 में अपनी मौत के समय तक पार्श्वगायन में सक्रिय रहे। [एजेसिया]
